ARSO and KATS COOPERATION Action Plan 2011-2015

"Desiring to promote mutual interest through collaboration and cooperation in the fields of standardization, conformity assessment and metrology on the basis of equality and mutual benefit"

The African Organization for Standardization(ARSO) and the Korean Agency for Technology and Standards(KATS) signed an MOU on 3rd December 2010 and acknowledged the importance and contribution of standardization and conformity assessment to value addition improvement, production efficacy and commercial exchange of goods and services. As a result the salient points in the MOU between ARSO and KATS are summarized in the paragraphs below:

- 1 The MOU between ARSO and KATS may support capacity building for harmonization of national, RECs(Regional Economic Communities) and international standards and shall encourage and improve global trade as well as consumer protection;
- 2 May support and help the capacity building programs to benefit both of the member States of ARSO and the Republic of Korea.
- 3 The parties solemnly agree to cooperate in the field of conformity assessment namely inspection and testing of products of mutual interest and share agreements and emerging proceeds in an open and transparent manner such that the membership of AU may benefit from such cooperation.
- 4 The parties hereby agree to exchange data or materials regarding the capacity building programs, and specialists or personnel for the purpose of studying experience and conducting consultations.
